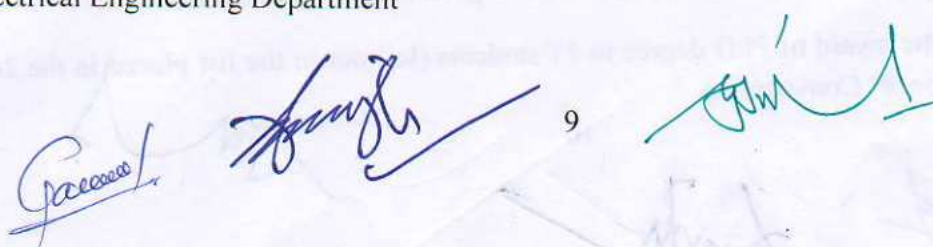

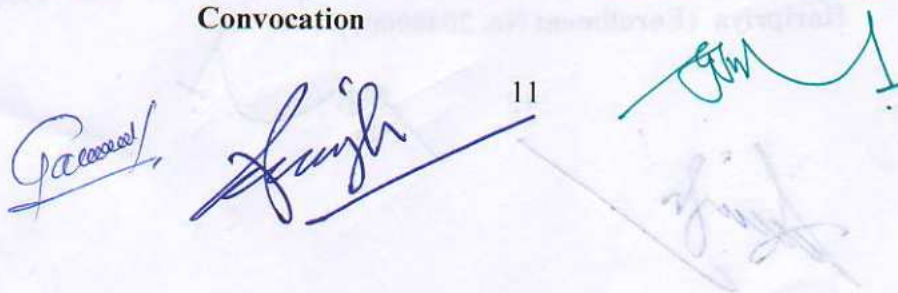

Taking into consideration of the NIRF ranking of the institute and for the growth of the young faculty members, the Chairman, Senate appraised the house to encourage faculty members to file Patents nationally and internationally.

After threadbare discussion and deliberation, the Senate recommended Rs. 50,000/- limit for Indian Patent filing and Rs. 1,00,000/- limit for International Patent Filing irrespective of countries from CPDA/IRG fund. The proposal are to be scrutinized by a committee at institute level.

The Senate also recommended 50% reimbursement for processing fee, 25% reimbursement at the time of publication and 25% reimbursement at the time of Grant of the Patent subject to approval by the Finance Committee and BoG. In case Rs. 1, 00,000/- limit exceeds, such request may be considered by senate on case to case basis.

SIX MONTHS INTERNSHIP POLICY

Guidelines and Procedures

Preamble:

Internship undoubtedly enhances the practical exposure and skills of a student and eventually his/her employability. At present, all engineering undergraduates are undergoing the following:

- Workshop Training after 2nd Semester, 4 Week Industrial Internship after 4th Semester, and 6-8 Week Industrial Internship after 6th Semester.
- In addition to this Institute may also permit B.Tech. students to undergo a 6-month internship cum placement (subject to the grant of specific permission by the Institute) during the 8th Semester of B. Tech. for which specific eligibility conditions are to be met by the students.
- The policy applies to the students for placements and will also be applicable to the students seeking a 6-month internship.

Key Points:

1. The students who want to avail of the 6-month internship during their 8th semester must not have more than 3 backlogs.
2. Students opting 6-month internship will be allowed to appear in campus placements like all other students.
3. The internships have to be strictly completed at least one week before the end of the semester assessment as mentioned in the academic calendar.
4. All such students who wish to undertake a 6-month internship or those who are selected for such an internship will have to give an undertaking that such an internship will not affect their academic output.

ANNEXURE: 3
Guidelines to the Departments:

1. Each department will form an "Internship advisory committee, IAC" to address all academic activities related to the internship, allotment of course, and all activities ranging from approving an internship to grading.

2. The committee will form an evaluation criterion for the internship as per the following guidelines:

- At the end of 6 months, each student is expected to submit a project report and make a presentation to a department-specific evaluation committee.
- Grades will be given based on the quality of both, the report and presentation, as well as on the report submitted by the external supervisor from the company.

Guidelines to the Students:

- Students who are interested in internships are required to register in the training & placements department.
- Students having three or more backlogs are not allowed to take this internship.
- 6-Month Internships are allowed only when students received a 6-Month Intern+ PPO from a company.

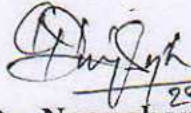

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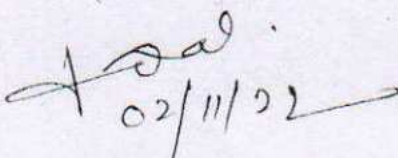
