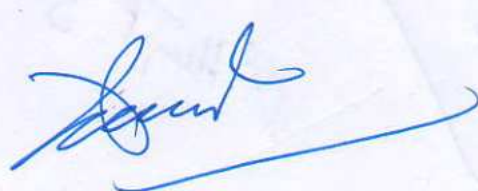

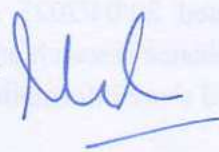
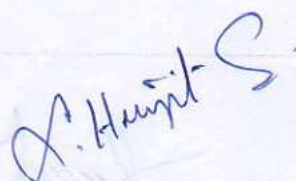

ITEM NO. 31.15: Discussion on the submission of Mr. Huiem Bharat Meitei (19405004) thesis

Mr. Huiem Bharat Meitei (19405004), a PhD student of Electronics and Communication Engineering Department is under the supervision of Dr. Manoj Kumar, Asst. Professor. He registered for the PhD programme on 03/02/2020.

After threadbare discussion and deliberation, the Senate considering the fact that the student is only three and half years in the PhD programme and to keep a Quality benchmark for the better future of the student directed the said student to publish one more SCI indexed paper for thesis submission.

ITEM NO.31.16: To ratify 45 days extension beyond the time frame of 9 years (for Part-Time PhD scholar) for Mr. Angom Buboo Singh thesis submission

Mr. Angom Buboo Singh (14PCS003) is a part time PhD scholar in the department of Computer Science and Engineering under the supervision of Prof. Kh. Manglem Singh. He registered for the PhD programme on 01/09/2014 thereby he completed 9 years on 31/08/2023 which is the maximum applicable extension for PHD part –time scholar. He gave his Pre-synopsis seminar on 31/08/2023, the last day of applicable maximum extension after fulfilling the criteria for the thesis submission. Mr. Buboo has requested the concerned DC to give him 45 days beyond the maximum time frame for his thesis submission. The DPPC meeting held on 04/09/2023 recommended an extension of 45 days to submit his thesis, since he met all the requirements for thesis submission. The Senate, Chairman has already approved the extension recommended by the concerned DPPC.

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After threadbare discussion and deliberation based on the Chairman, Senate's approval on the recommendation of the DPPC meeting held on 04/09/2023, the Senate ratified to give Mr. Angom Buboo Singh 45 days beyond the maximum time frame for thesis submission.

3. To consider and approve to modify Item No. 25.8.g resolution of 25th Senate meeting held on 10/05/2022

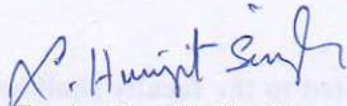

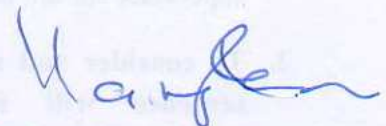

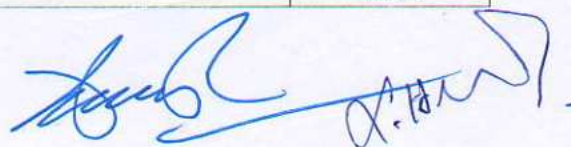
