1. “Construction of Water Treatment Plant in the Adopted villages” National Institute of Technology Manipur

NIT Manipur under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan adopted 5 (five) villages at Nambol, Bishnupur District of Manipur namely- Nambol Makha, Kongkham Awang, Maibam Chingmang, Nambol Bazar & Koriphaba. A low cost 9000 L water treatment plant based on roughing and biosand filter was constructed at Nambol by NIT under UBA on 27th August 2016. The treatment plant serves the villagers within 3 km radius. Another 2nd water treatment plant was constructed and handed over to villagers of Maibam Chingmang in April 2018.

2. “Awareness Programme on Health and Sanitation & Swachhata hi Seva Campaign” 14th September 2019

For making plastics- free villages, “Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign” was started from 14th September 2019 in the adopted villages. To initiate, the campaign in the Nambol Makha and Maibam Chingmang on 14th September 2019, as requested by the villagers for an awareness program, “Swachhata Hi Seva” was conducted in merge with the awareness program on health and sanitation. On this occasion, important information about the health problems and their management were provided to the villagers. Prof. P. Albino Kumar (Regional Coordinator) highlighted the importance of practicing personal hygienic measures and eating balanced diet in day today life .People were illuminated the harmful consequences from the use of plastic in our health. The villagers9 queries and other related issues raised by them were entertained and discussed during the programme.

Cloth bags were distributed to the villagers as an initiative to use cloth bags instead of plastic bags. However, villagers have mentioned the problems arise in the adequate collection, place to discard and recycling system. So, in guidelines, they were advised to encourage Youth Club, organize social service program every weekend and construct a dustbin or compost pit to discard plastic bags which later will be disposed of by Municipality Members.

To make the campaign more effective and to spread the message “No more plastic bags”, the campaign is followed by the presentation about the problems arise due to the use of plastics. The presentation gave outstanding result in terms of learning and sharing knowledge. Moreover, students became clear about the effects of plastics on human health and how it affects our body.

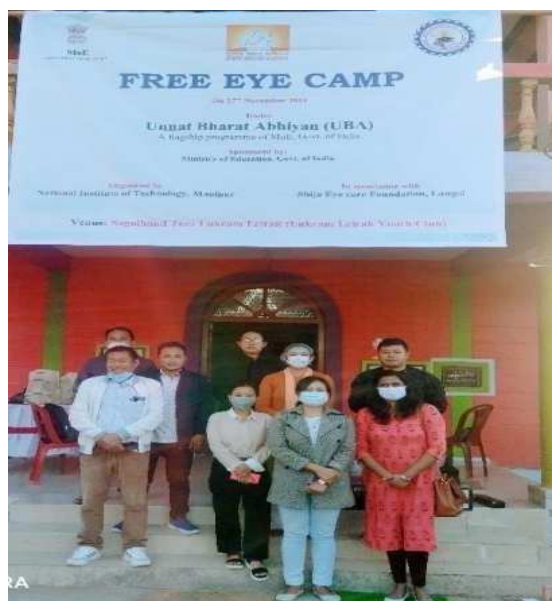

13. Free Eye Camp At Sagolband Tera Lukram Leirak 27th November 2021

A Free Eye Camp was organised on 27th November 2021 at Sagolband Tera Lukram Leirak, Lukram Leirak Youth Club (LLYC) in association with Shija Eye Care Foundation, Langol under the Perennial fund. The Free Eye Camp was successfully conducted from 9:30 am till 3:30 pm. The camp was successfully organised with the active participation of the volunteers of the club (LLYC). A team of 7 members from Shija Hospital provided the technical support for conducting the camp. The Technical team of the Shija Hospital included Dr. Rakhi Raj, an Ophthalmologist; four Ophthalmic Assistants: Ms. Menaka Lourembam, Ms. Bidyaluxmi Thongbam, Ms. Soram Sarju, and Ms. Riya Huirem; Ms. Ratna Nongmaithem, Nursing Officer; and Camp Coordinator, Mr. Rohenjit Maibam. During the eye check-up, the entire team along with the Volunteers and UBA NIT Team ensured the villagers coming in were guided properly. A total of 122 patients were examined for eye problems and diseases. A total of 21 patients were diagnosed with cataracts, 6 pterygia, and 1 chalazion. They were all referred to Shija Hospital, Langol where they will be operated on or necessary procedures will be given. All the necessary support for the above surgeries will be provided free of course by Shija Hospital. Overall, the teams were very enthusiastic and contributed their active participation in the camp.

14. “Covid Awareness campaign and distribution of essential items in the adopted village” at Nambol Bazar

2nd January 2022 till 11th January 2022

14.1 Nambol Bazar

As the Covid issue is at the highest peak in our state. Under this condition, people's adherence to preventive measures is greatly affected by their awareness of the disease. Therefore, awareness on the Covid disease and its preventive measures should be spread to the villagers especially the illiterate, street vendors, etc. So, a Covid Awareness campaign was organized at Nambol Bazar, an adopted village on 2nd January 2021. The campaign was conducted with Mtech, BTech, students and research scholars of our college. The students interacted with local women, elders and street vendors who are the main centre for the spreading of infection. The villagers were thoroughly educated about the preventive measures such as 6ft social distancing, proper washing of hands, importance of vaccination, etc.

In addition, they identified some of the worst affected family due to Covid in the village. A total of 12 families were distributed with the essential items such as rice, grain, onion, soap, potato, oil, mask, sanitizer, etc. The campaign conducted was worthwhile, it made the villagers aware of the information, preventive measures and also help them well prepared to fight against COVID-19

14.2. Koriphaba

UBA NIT Manipur organized the Covid awareness campaign at Koriphaba, an adopted village on 3rd & 4th January 2022 and was continued for two days. In order to avoid social gathering of the people, UBA NIT team and students divided into groups for spreading the awareness and distribution of information printed on flyers. The campaign emphasized in various COVID-19 prevention efforts, including health education and innovative strategies based on local evidences to raise the community's awareness and to improve its preventative practices. Based on the campaign survey in the village, 13 and 13 families were distributed with essential items on the first and second day respectively. The unvaccinated villagers were also convinced to go for covid19 vaccination.

14.3. Sadokpham Leikai

Another awareness campaign was organized on 11th January 2022 at Sadokpham Leikai in continuation of the above campaign held in other adopted villages. The scenario of the Covid situation in the village was studied properly by the student and UBA NIT team. During the campaign, villagers were educated about their responsibility, their contribution in taking all the precautionary measures such as regular

hand washing, proper wearing of face masks and keeping social distancing. Flyers on proper wearing of face mask, social distancing, vaccination, mental health and alternatives to handshake to avoid COVID-19 infection were distributed to the villagers. The worst infected 12 families by the covid19 crisis were distributed with some necessary items.

16. Covid 19 Awareness programme for the village children

15th January 2022 & 18th January 2022

16.1. Lukram Leirak Ward no. 1 (15/01/2022)

Covid 19 has been the biggest health challenge of the century globally. There has been so much said about the ongoing corona virus (COVID-19) outbreak and it can be easy to feel overwhelmed. In our state, Manipur, adults as well as children especially in villages, struggle to understand or put in context, the things they are hearing from friends, family and the media. Therefore, organizing awareness program among the children is pertinent to educate the children about the accurate information and science based facts about COVID 19. With this view, an awareness programme on COVID 19 for village children (40 children) was organized on 15th January 2022 at Lukram Leirak Ward No. 1, an adopted village by NIT Manipur. The awareness program was conducted with the help of an expert, Ms. Thoidingjam Abemma (Nurse). During the programme, the village childrens concerned about the diseases were listened, their questions were answered in an age appropriate manner not overwhelmed them with too much information. The children were taught about the importance of mask wearing and washing their hands regularly, among other safety norms to protect themselves from the infection. Several good health behaviours to prevent Corona virus, such as washing hands for 20 seconds, covering cough and sneezes with the elbow, physical distancing, etc. were demonstrated to the children by the expert. The children were also trained with some basic yoga practices. At the end of the program, stationary items such as book, pen, and pencil were distributed to the children in order to encourage them to study during this tough time

16.2. Kongkham Awang Leikai (18/01/2022)

Another Covid 19 awareness programme for the village children was organized and conducted in another adopted village by NIT Manipur, Kongkham Awang Leikai, on 18th January 2022. The Covid awareness preventive measures and other necessary practices were demonstrated by the invited expert, Ms. Nongmaithem Pinky (teacher) along with the UBA NIT team to 60 children. The awareness programme among the village children was conducted as an effort to impart knowledge related to COVID among children in order to protect them from infection as well as to develop social and scientific consciousness among them. During the programme, a favourable environment was created for the overall development of the children, built their confidence and also soothed the anxieties and worries in them at the time of present COVID crisis. The children were sensitized about the importance of washing their hands frequently and properly, maintaining social distance of 6ft from other, exercising daily and practicing other healthy habits to avoid falling sick. The children learnt a lot from

the awareness programme and promised to follow all the good habits as instructed by the expert.

- Master the use of swing machine and take care of the machine.
- Select fabric and appropriate colour combinations according to age, tradition. Vocation and personality
- Follow precautions while using a machine. Identify and correct the defects in a machine. Identify and correct the defects in a machine.

Day 2: The following trainings were accomplished:

- Follow rules of pattern making, layout and fabric estimation
- Design, draft, pattern making cutting, stitching and finishing of the clothes, mosquito net, etc.
- Surface decoration of garments using embroidery, laces, buttons, beads, sequins etc
- Marking and storing of drafts and patterns for future use.

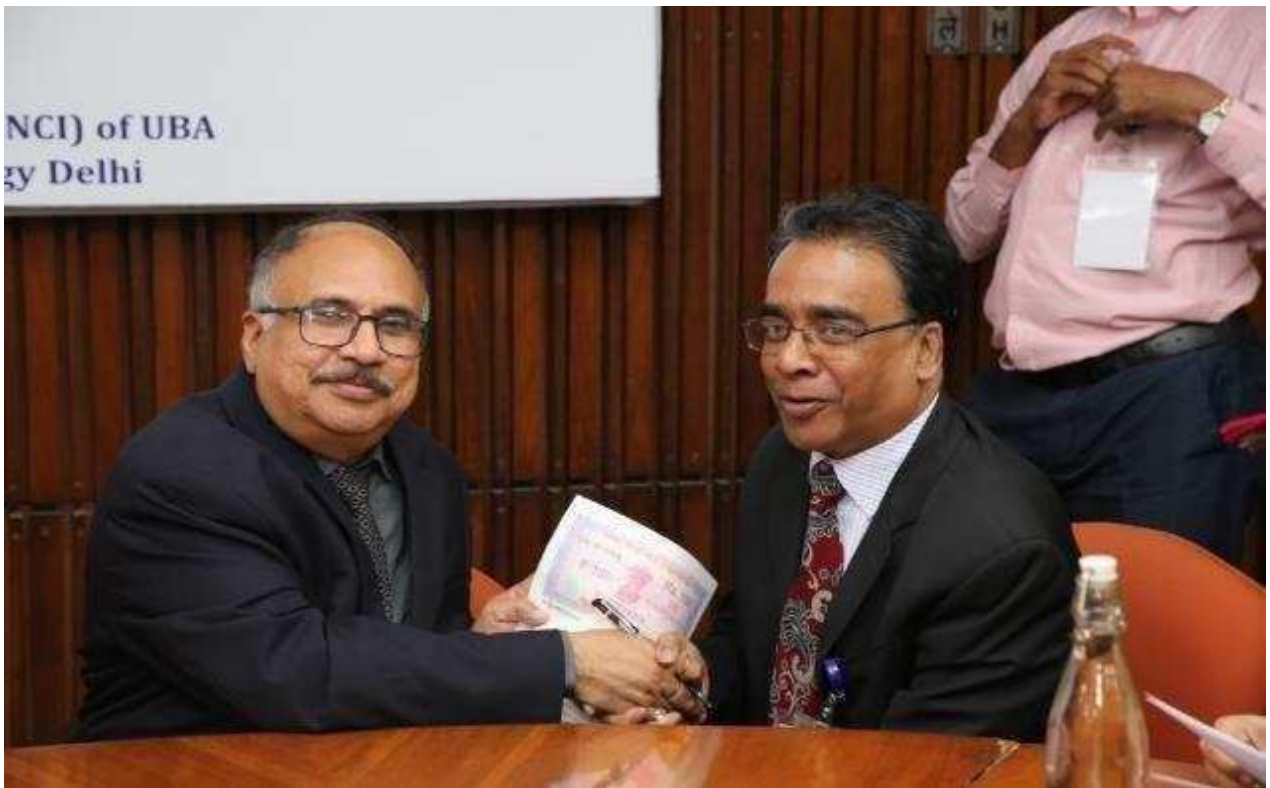

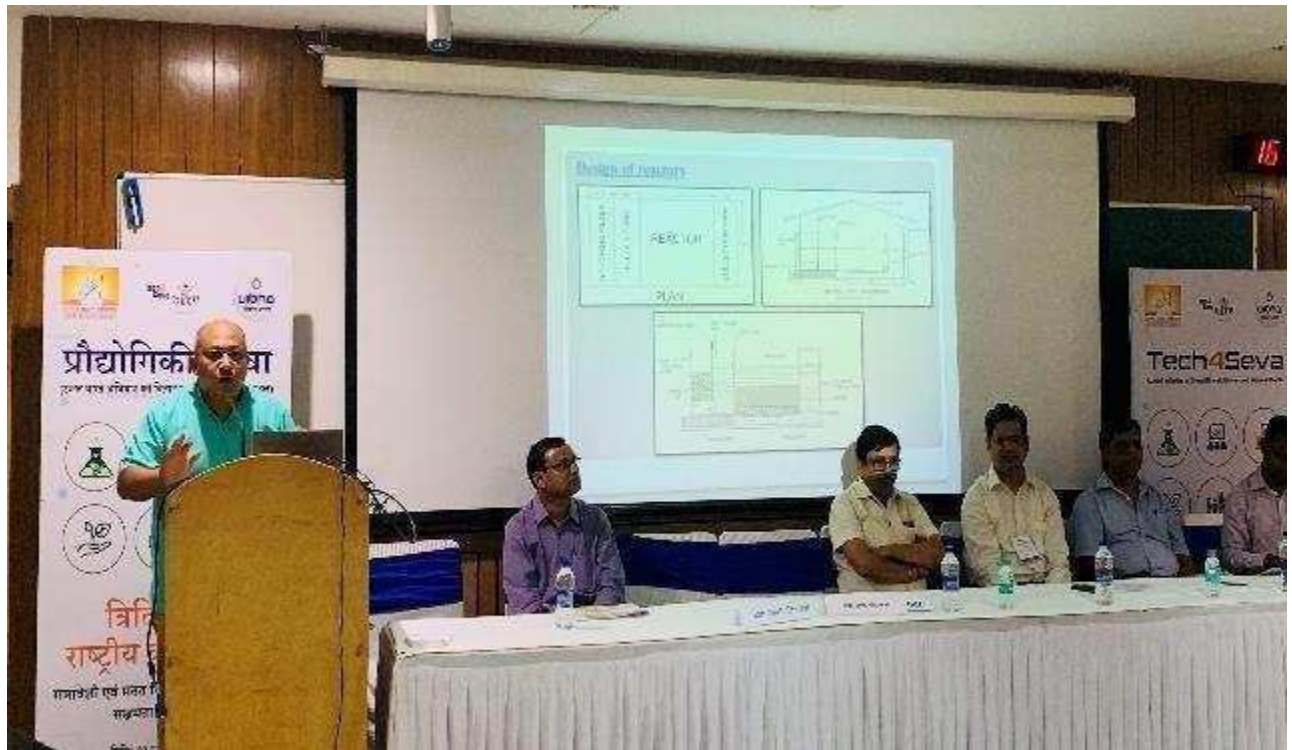
